

What's new in AHFS Drug Information October update 2009

AHFS Drug Information is continually undergoing re-validation and revision. Each month, new and revised sections are published on MedicinesComplete. This is a list of the changes made since the last update.

This update contains 4 new monographs and 30 revised monographs. Highlights include MedWatch alerts from September (Promethazine, Oseltamivir, Certolizumab, Sitagliptin, Etanercept, Infliximab, Adalimumab, and Natalizumab); Revisions due to updated therapeutic guidelines or labeling (Delavirdine, Nevirapine, Lopinavir/Ritonavir, Enfuvirtide, Stavudine, Saquinavir, Indinavir, Didanosine, Olmesartan, Hepatitis B Immune Globulin, and Hepatitis B Vaccine). Valsartan was expanded from a SumMon to an Overview monograph (Cautions and Drug Interactions sections added; updated labeling, guidelines, and additional references from primary literature included). This update also includes new monographs and revisions based on the 2009-2010 flu vaccine season.
