

What's new in AHFS Drug Information December update 2009

AHFS Drug Information is continually undergoing re-validation and revision. Each month, new and revised sections are published on MedicinesComplete. This is a list of the changes made since the last update.

This update contains 40 revised monographs and 4 new monographs.

MedWatch alerts are included from November (Voriconazole, Etravirine, Ketoconazole, Fluconazole, Ticlopidine, Fluoxetine, Felbamate, Fluvoxamine, Sibutramine, Cimetidine, Omeprazole, Lidocaine, Mepivacaine, Bupivacaine); Vorinostat, Everolimus, Plerixafor, Eltrombopag were updated from FirstReleases to Overview monographs (expanded cautionary information); Gemcitabine, Arformoterol, Losartan were expanded from Summary Monographs to Overviews (expanded cautionary information and drug interactions); the remaining revisions are due to updated therapeutic guidelines or labeling.
